

## Common Law Admission Test (CLAT)

About CLAT: - Started in 2008, the CLAT exam is an All India Entrance Examination conducted by 14 National Law Universities for admissions to their Undergraduate (LL.B.) and Postgraduate (LL.M.) degree programmes. There are around 1600 seats available in these Universities.

#### Eligibility for Under-Graduate Programmes

- A candidate should have obtained a Senior Secondary School/Intermediate (10+2) or its
  equivalent qualification from a recognised Board with not less than 50% marks in aggregate
  (45% in case of SC/ST/OBC and PWD).
- Candidates who have appeared in the 10+2 examination and are awaiting for results are also
  eligible to appear in the test. Age of candidate should not be more than 20 years in case of
  General/OBC candidates (22 years in case of SC/ST and persons with Disability)\*\* as on 1st
  July. The candidate must have passed the qualifying examination at the time of his/her
  admission and be able to submit its proof (Subject to State reservation at the University
  concerned).

## How to Apply & Submit Application Form

- ♦ DIRECT ADMISSION subject to minimum eligibility as given in Information Leaflet (Academic Session 2013-14) of CLAT.
- Purchase Admission Packet from Resonance Commerce & LAW Programme Division's, Talwandi Campus by paying Rs. 200/- (inclusive of Taxes) through Cash or Bank Demand Draft in favour of 'Resonance' payable at Kota.

Contents of Admission Packet:

- ◆ Application Form ◆ Information Leaflet (Academic Session 2013-14) ◆ Reso Guide
- Deposit the filled-in application form at Resonance Commerce & CLAT Division Campus along with applicable course fee through Bank Demand Draft / pay order in favour of 'Resonance' payable at Kota. The complete course fee has to be deposited at the time of admission only.

## Instruction for Fee Submission

### (A) Through DD/Pay Order:

- The course fee can be deposited through a Demand Draft or Pay Order made in favour of "RESONANCE" and payable at Kota. The DD / pay order Can be deposited in person at Resonance CLPD Talwandi campus.
- The student must write his/her Name, Father's Name, Course and Application Form No. on the Back of DD/ Pay order while depositing the course fee.
